

# How to receive credit for missed work.

Any student who misses one or more days should ask the teacher for missed work. A complete section in the book shelf by the teacher desk is donated to student work, handouts, projects, etc. Students are graded on the following items:

- Daily Performance Booster & Class Notes** - this form is passed out the first of each week and turned in on the last day of each week. 100 pts.  
Possible/Week, 20 pts. per day
- Worksheets**, typically worth 30 - 50 pts. each
- Projects**, usually take up to one or more periods to complete and are over 100 pts. in value.
- Lab project** monitored throughout (quarter) reporting period, this would likely be over 100 pts.

Student work can be turned in up to the last day of the grading period. Here are some **options** you can use to make up work missed:

- Read a chapter in a book** and write a 3/4 page report on what the chapter was about. (50 pts.) Books available upon request in classroom.
- Pick up a magazine** from the bookshelf in the classroom, read an article at least 2 pages long and write a review that would be at least 1/2 page. (25 pts.)
- Pick up the worksheet** that you missed and complete it.
- Special Project**: This is a project that you decide to do that deals with some part of the agriculture lab and/or animals we have here at the school. You could do a demonstration, you could make something or even pick a specific area out in the land lab and keep it weeded and clean for the reporting period (quarter). (50 - 100 pts.)
