

Agriscience/Vet Tech Student Expectations

1. **All PCSB and CLMS rules must be followed.** This includes dress code, electronic devices, cell phones, and behavior. Refer to **page 15** of the student agenda for specific steps used in disciplinary action.
2. **You are to be in your seat, with your PRIDE binder, when the 2nd bell rings.** Only 6th graders traveling from the other side of the school get 1 extra minute. The CLMS tardy policy will be strictly followed! Refer to **page 6** of student agenda.
3. At **no time** are you to leave the classroom or lab areas without specific permission from Mr. Egan.
4. All chairs are to be pushed up to the table, tables straightened and all material put away before you are excused. **Students will not line up at the door.** All four legs of your chair are to remain on the floor at all times.
5. **No student is to be in the office/computer lab without permission.** FFA members and officers preparing for events and student aids may be allowed to be in the office during class time. Rules for the office/computer are posted on the door and students not following the rules **WILL NOT** be allowed in this area again.
6. The agriscience department is a place for learning. Students are expected to behave in an orderly manner. **Talking out of turn, horseplay, or disturbing other students will not be tolerated** in any of the agriscience/Vet Tech areas.
7. **When an adult is talking, either in front of the class or by intercom, there is NO talking.** Horseplay, or disturbing other students time.
8. **Food and/or drink**, Country Meat snacks are available again this year. We will also be selling Propel and water. These are the **only appropriate items** to be eaten or consumed in class. A student may bring his/her own water.
9. **Restrooms**, you need approval from Mr. Egan to use the restroom. You will use the agriscience bathrooms. If the facilities are abused (garbage, graffiti, etc.) they will be locked. Restroom permission will not be granted until 10 minutes after the bell from the start of class or 10 minutes before release.
10. **Use common sense** and courtesy to all students and staff.
11. **Defacing or destruction** of any materials, including books, tools, furniture, walls, restrooms, etc. is a serious violation and will result in an office referral.
12. Any **behavior** that results in the safety of anyone being compromised will result in an office referral.
13. Agriscience/Vet Tech Lab Areas:
 - a. The lab areas include the ag shop, tool rooms, rabbit area, chicken, turkey and goat area, horse, citrus arboretum, garden area, aquaculture building, hydroponics greenhouse, and the plant and flower areas around the building and school.
 - b. Working in the lab areas is a privilege and must be earned and maintained.
 - c. **All students must behave** in an orderly and safe manner or the **entire class will lose lab time.**
 - d. All backpacks and personal items will be left in the classroom during lab time, the room is locked.

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- e. The lab is for everyone, you are expected to stay with the group whether you participate in an activity or not.
 - f. You are not allowed back into the ag building without permission.
 - g. All tools will be returned to their proper place unless instructed otherwise. This is everyone's responsibility.
 - h. Report any injuries to Mr. Egan immediately.
14. Working with animals in the classroom or lab is earned and not just freely given. You will have a separate handout that identifies class and lab requirements.
